


Red Shoulder Hawk Trail (0.8 mile)

This trail has two foot bridge crossings and a bird blind to observe birds in the marsh. It connects to Wood duck trail on the south end and Redshouldered Trail on the north.



This is a level, easily walked trail. It winds through a pine grove and is adjacent to the wheelchair accessible birding area and Raptor rehab flight chamber



This trail winds along the tributaries of Clear Fork. Beaver activity and an active dam can be observed along the boardwalk. Seasonally this trail can flood and be slick.





This trail branches off and can

be traveled in either direction.

Birds such as wrens, warblers,

Scarlet Tanagers, and Song

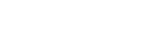
sparrows can be spotted on this


